

## Notification of Apprenticeship Announcement

### Where to Apply:

All interested applicants shall make applications on forms provided by the apprenticeship committee at Evco Sound and Electronics.

Applications are available year round Monday through Thursday, excluding holidays. Applications must be picked up in person at 3511 E Trent Ave, Spokane, WA 99202.

### Minimum Qualifications:

Age:	Applicant shall be at least 18 years of age
Education:	Have a 12 <sup>th</sup> grade education or certified equivalency
Physical:	Physically able to do the work of the trade
Testing:	N/A
Other:	High school algebra with a passing score of 70%

Completed applications shall contain the following supporting applicant documentation:

- o Completed and legible application for apprenticeship.
- o Current drivers license that provides proof of age, must be 18 or older
- o High school diploma or proof of GED.
- o Transcriptions verifying high school algebra with a 70% passing score.
- o Copy of Social Security Card
- o Copy of DD-214, if applicable

***An application will not be considered complete unless all required documentation is included with the completed application. An incomplete application will make the applicant ineligible for consideration.***

If the applicant wishes to supplement the application, they may submit 3 letters of recommendation and a detailed work history, including military service, technical training and/or education, including previous electrical work experience that shall be verifiable through state or federal electrical licensing entities.

The committee will notify the applicant of their interview date and time.

All applicant applications shall remain on the eligibility list for a period of two (2) years unless they request in writing to be removed from the list.
