- Jeff Killip
 - Reviewed 2 handouts (biweekly and monthly rule summaries). Regarding Global Harmonization (GH), will incorporate the GH rule into the Ag rule. For penalty calculation rulemaking, will conduct additional stakeholdering to obtain stakeholder input. Staggered effective dates on the Hazardous Drugs. eRules will reformat all DOSH rules so they can be easily accessed and navigated via mobile devices.

 - Algorithm update
We are getting closer to cleaning up. Will hire a designer to make it look better.
 - Establish a subcommittee for compliance and interpretation FAQ's -20 minutes
March 2 WSPSA
 - Ship Grant for pharmacy specific Hazardous Drug looking outside of NIOSH to see what is best practices. What is the better decision making process? We are a little behind but making great progress.

PhRMA – upstream measures in reducing exposures this is about packaging. New algorithm went to the group and is being reviewed. We will give another chance to discuss at the next meeting. This rule will give new opportunities for marketing. There should be an invitation to the Pharma organization outreach, if there is a new standard of packaging. We need to bridge the gap.

Next meeting April 8 should we have someone come to this meeting? Collection of human waste is important in Rhode Island. Rhode Island is adopting a rule requiring collecting human waste. Maybe we should include someone from DOE. We should be addressing employee's exposure.
